JOHN LOCKE (1632-1704)

*Two Treatises of Civil Government*, 1690. Introduction by Prof. W. S. Carpenter. A defence of the Revolution of 1688.

*Essay Concerning the Human Understanding*, 1690. Abridged by Raymond Wilburn, presenting the whole sweep of the work.

BENEDICTUS DE SPINOZA (1632-77)

*Ethics* (1677), and, *On the Correction of the Understanding* (1687). Translated by Andrew Boyle. New Introduction by T. S. Gregory. The position of Spinoza, the 'God-intoxicated' man, in the history of philosophy is midway between Descartes (*A Discourse on Method*, etc., No. 570) and the modern German school.
