BE it enacted by Parliament in the Sixty-first Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Essential Commodities (Amendment) Act, 2010.

2. In section 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955, in sub-section (3C), the *Explanation* shall be numbered as *Explanation I*, and after *Explanation I* as so numbered,
